Home to School Service (H2SS)

The Home to School Service (H2SS) is provided directly by the School and offers a door-to-door or local designated pick up point service.

These routes use a minibus with pick-up points as shown on the map below and are invoiced through the School fees account.

- H2SS Spalding: Cowbit, Spalding, Holbeach, Gedney, Long Sutton and Newton in the Isle
- H2SS Watlington: Runcton Holme, Watlington, Tilney St Lawrence, Marshland St James and Emneth
- H2SS Middletons: Kings Lynn, Terrington St Clements, Walton Highway
- H2SS Downham Market Direct: Shouldham and Downham Market
- H2SS Downham Market Rural: Marham, Fincham, West Dereham, Downham Market, Upwell Outwell, Elm and Friday Bridge
- H2SS Chatteris: Warboys, Somersham, Chatteris, Wimblington
- H2SS March: March
- H2SS March Express: March
- H2SS Ramsey: Ramsey, Benwick, Doddington, Wimblington and March
- H2SS Peterborough: Peterborough, Whittlesey and Coates

All age pupils are able to join a H2SS minibus, however the preference is for pupils to be in P3 and older (age 7 and up). Where younger pupils wish to join the bus, this will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Harrods

Harrods Coaches have a traditional bus route along the A47 corridor from Hunstanton through King's Lynn for many years, with bus stop pick-ups for pupils from Prep 3 and older. This routes use a coach with pick-up points as shown on the map below (currently being updated) and are invoiced directly through the School fees account.

- W23 – Hunstanton, Heacham, Snettisham, Ingoldisthorpe, Dersingham, North Wootton, South Wootton, Gayton and Hardwick.
