Schoolblazer offers a convenient one-stop shop for all items your child may need during the school day. However, some non-branded items may be purchased elsewhere if preferred, and certain items are optional, such as a baseball cap. Mandatory branded items are clearly indicated on the uniform list with the Schoolblazer logo and must be purchased from Schoolblazer. For pupils who do not attend Team Sport fixtures the Sport kit remains with Schoolblazer.

For pupils participating in team sports, Grays Teamsports provides the required kit from Third Form onwards. Please visit the Grays website and select your sport to view the relevant uniform.

Appearance

- Pupils should be clean shaven
- Jewellery, make-up and nail varnish must be subtle
- Hair should be your own natural colour
- Belts should be plain, regular width with a modest buckle
- Facial and body piercings are not permitted
- Tattoos are not permitted

Suit

- Pupils will wear either a matching full length trouser or skirt suit, or a tailored dress and jacket
- Patterns are permissible only if they are subtle and reflect the principle of smart professional attire (e.g. modest pin stripe)
- Skirts and dresses should be at least knee length, short skirts are not permitted
- If worn, tights should be black, navy or neutral coloured and plain in pattern

Footwear








- Black formal shoes, capable of taking polish should be worn
- Boots and canvas shoes are not permitted
- High heels are unsuitable for the requirements of the school day and should not be worn
- Open-toes shoes or sling backs are not permitted to be worn

Sixth Form Uniform

Uniform	
Collared Shirt/Blouse	Plain shirts or blouses in pale colours with formal collar and sleeves are to be worn. They must be professionally tailored, made from opaque fabric and may be plain or modestly patterned. All shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times, with the top button fastened and concealed by the tie knot. Polo necks, casual T-shirts and low cut styles are not permitted, and midriffs must not be exposed.
Tie	Pupils can choose to wear the Wisbech Grammar School Sixth Form Tie, a School Colours Tie or a Sports Representatives Tie (e.g. 1st VII Hockey).
Waistcoat	Waistcoats, plain or dark coloured may accompany a suit.
Jumper	Pupils can wear smart, plain, fine-knit jumper or sleeveless sweater underneath their suit jacket. Wearing any of these is not a substitute for a jacket. They must be black, grey or navy blue with no pattern.
Coat	A dark coloured formal coat may be worn, but not indoors, and it is not a substitute for wearing a jacket. It should not have ostentatious branding on it. Hoodies are not acceptable.
Scarf	Scarves can be worn during periods of cold weather, but not indoors. These should either be Wisbech Grammar School scarves or plain dark coloured scarves.
Religious Clothing	Where an item of religious clothing is worn, this should be plain in design.
Shoes	Plain navy or black leather of standard pattern
Lab Coat*	White lab coat – Popper fasteners not buttons
F&N Apron*	Blue and white apron
